



Prevent delays, check your height!

Did you know that...

- European regulations state that goods vehicles may not exceed four metres in height?
- delays to you and all other traffic can run to around 20 minutes if a tunnel is closed due to a goods vehicle that is too tall?
- this comes at a high cost to society?
- you risk a fine of 700 to 900 euros if you drive into a tunnel in a goods vehicle that is too high?

Automatic height alert, 1st checkpoint. Too high? Take the next exit!

Stop and follow the instructions in the announcement!

Too high again at the 2nd checkpoint? Then we lower the speed and close the tunnel.

Measures you should take

- always measure the height of your vehicle after loading.
- make sure your load does not protrude above your vehicle and fasten tarpaulins securely.
- do you need to drive on public roads with a vehicle higher than four metres? Then you must apply for an exemption and an alternative route from the [Rijksdienst voor het Wegverkeer](#) [Netherlands Vehicle Authority].
